Parking Policy

Introduction:

There are three public off-road parking areas in Morchard Bishop:

- i) The village car park adjacent to the school. Owned by Morchard Bishop Parish Council.
- ii) Parking in front of Nos 1 – 6 Church Street, which is reserved for the occupants of 1 – 6 Church Street, whose gardens were reduced to create the parking lay-by. Owned by Mid Devon District Council.
- iii) At Bishop's Meadow, which was adopted by Devon County Council when the Bishop's Meadow road was adopted.

These regulations only apply to the village car park.

Regulations:

- Parking is on a first come, first served basis.
- No overnight parking of campervans and caravans
- No maintenance work on vehicles beyond that needed to start the vehicle
- Parking is not permitted for unroadworthy, SORN, untaxed, and non-MOT and abandoned vehicles.
- Avoid obstructing other vehicles, access to properties and access for emergency services.
- Avoid causing noise nuisance or driving at an inappropriate speed.
- Avoid anti-social and criminal behaviour
